

Activities for Week Beginning 5th May 2020 – 1st, 2nd 3rd Class

In order to help your child continue with their learning we suggest:

- Give your child a Spelling Pretest on a Monday to form a list for learning that week
- Tables should be practised daily
- Free writing / Saorscribhneoireacht– English on Monday, Wednesday & Friday and Gaeilge on Tuesday & Thursday – 10 mins daily
- Practise your Comhrá Scoile daily
