

Activities for Week Beginning 25th May 2020 – Rang a 4, 5 & 6

In order to help your child continue with their learning we suggest:

- Give your child a Spelling Pre-test on a Monday to form a list for learning that week
- Tables should be practised daily
- Free writing daily – English on Monday, Wednesday & Friday and Gaeilge on Tuesday & Thursday. Use Narrative writing, Reports, Recounts, Letter writing, Poetry, Persuasive writing or Procedural writing. (10-20 mins)
- Practise your Comhrá Scoile daily
- Try to be active for at least 30 minutes per day – use Super Troopers, RTÉ 10@10, Joe Wicks' online PE lessons or some of your own ideas.

Choose what you and your child can manage at this time. Stay safe and stay connected to those close to you.
